AUSTRALIA | RMIT Univeristy

RMIT offers courses in fashion design, fashion & textile merchandising, footwear, textile design, and textile technology, in addition to courses in the School of Design.

AUSTRALIA | University of the Sunshine Coast

USC offers courses in design, in addition to internship opportunities in graphic design and marketing.

CHINA | Donghua University Fashion Institute

The program is a collaboration between NC State, Fashion Institute of Technology (NYC), and Donghua University (Shanghai) focusing on global textile management and brand marketing in addition to language and culture. Students may earn credit for FTM 482, two FTM electives, and two GEP's.

CZECH REPUBLIC | Prague Institute

The Prague Institute offers design and GEP courses through the NC State College of Design. Students also have opportunities to attend cultural events and participate on group excursions.
